



Minor Release and Liability Waiver

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the "Release"), executed on this ____ day of _____, 20____ by _____ (the "Volunteer") [or the legal guardian of Volunteer(s), _____, if under 18] in favor of Habitat for Humanity International, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, and Habitat for Humanity of the Coachella Valley Inc., a California nonprofit corporation, its directors, officers, employees and agents (collectively, "Habitat"). If the Volunteer is under the age of 18, the legal guardian of the Volunteer agrees to all the terms and provisions set forth below on behalf of the Volunteer.

The Volunteer desires to participate as a volunteer for Habitat and engage in the activities related to being a volunteer (the "Activities"). The Volunteer understands that the activities may include constructing, deconstructing, and rehabilitating residential buildings, working in Habitat offices, being transported to and from work locations, working at special events and consuming food and living in accommodations provided for volunteers of Habitat.

The Volunteer hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

1. Release and Waiver. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless Habitat and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's Activities with Habitat.

Volunteer understands that this Release discharges Habitat from any liability or claim that the Volunteer may have against Habitat with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death or property damage that may result from Volunteer's Activities with Habitat, whether caused by the negligence of Habitat or its officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. Volunteer also understands that Habitat does not assume any responsibility for, or obligation to, provide financial assistance or other assistance including, but not limited to, medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

2. Medical Treatment. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge Habitat from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat.

3. Assumption of the Risk. The Volunteer understands that Activities may include work that can be hazardous to the Volunteer, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from the work sites, and that the food, accommodations, and medical facilities may be donated and beyond the control of Habitat.

Volunteer hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in these activities and releases Habitat from all liability for injury, illness, death or property damage resulting from the activities of the Volunteer's participation with Habitat.

4. Insurance. The Volunteer understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by Habitat in writing, Habitat is not obligated to, and does not carry insurance or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer.

Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to arrive with medical or health insurance coverage in effect.

5. Photographic Release. Volunteer does hereby grant and convey unto Habitat all right, title and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by Habitat during the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat, including but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.

6. **Other.** Volunteer expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of California, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of California. Volunteer agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.
