## **ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND** RELEASE FROM RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT

- 1. I have voluntarily applied to Habitat for Humanity of Orange County ("Habitat for Humanity") to participate in construction and other related activities at various locations in Orange County. Some of these related activities include, but are not limited to, the salvaging of salable materials from various locations in Orange County ("Deconstruction"), construction of new homes, assisting at the Habitat ReStores, and rehabilitating existing homes. All of the activities referred to in this paragraph are referred to collectively as "Habitat Activities."
- As consideration for being permitted by Habitat for Humanity to participate in Habitat Activities and use their tools and 2. facilities, I agree that neither I nor my assignees, heirs, distributees, guardians or legal representatives will make any claim against, sue, or take any other action against Habitat for Humanity, any Owner or family thereof, of the home undergoing Deconstruction, or the suppliers of any of the tools or equipment (collectively, "Released Entities") I may use in Habitat Activities, for injury or damage to me, my property or to any other person or property, resulting from or arising out of my participation in any Habitat Activities, whether caused by or resulting from the negligence or other acts or omissions of Habitat for Humanity or the Released Entities.
- 3. SPECIAL NOTICE ABOUT DECONSTRUCTION: In projects of this nature, when Habitat enters private homes to remove items that Habitat may be able to sell ("Salable Items"), there are likely to be many unknown factors, and some of them could be dangerous. It is not possible to know of any of these hazards before the project begins, or even as it is in progress, as hazards may be discovered during the removal of these items. It is not possible for either Habitat for Humanity or the Released Entities to be aware of all the conditions that might exist, even when the structure is exposed. Volunteers understand that he/she may be exposed to mold or other hazardous substance when removing Salable Items. Exposure to mold or other hazardous substances for extended periods of time can cause illness or other bodily injury. Volunteers assume the risk to protect themselves by wearing appropriate protective equipment. - 5. I hereby release and forever discharge Habitat for Humanity from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or participation in Habitat Activities.
- 6. I understand that Habitat for Humanity does not carry or maintain health or disability insurance coverage for any volunteer. EACH VOLUNTEER IS EXPECTED AND ENCOURAGED TO ARRIVE WITH HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE IN EFFECT.
- 7. I hereby expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of California, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of California. I hereby agree that in the event that any clause in this agreement is made invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release and said provisions shall continue to be enforceable.
- 8. I AM AWARE THAT CONSTRUCTION IS A HAZARDOUS ACTIVITY. I AM VOLUNTARILY PARTICIPATING IN THE ACTIVITIES OF CONSTRUCTION WITH THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE DANGER INVOLVED AND WITH THE KNOWLEDGE THAT MEDICAL FACILITIES MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE IN THE EVENT OF INJURY TO ME. I HEREBY AGREE TO ACCEPT ANY AND ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR DEATH, AND VERIFY THIS STATEMENT BY
