"Vo	Release and Waiver of Liability (the "Release") executed on thisday of, 20, by, a minor child (the unteer"), and, the parent having legal custody and/or the legal guardian of the Volunteer (the "Guardian"), in or of Habitat for Humanity International, Inc. and Habitat for Humanity of Benton County, Inc., an Arkansas non-profit corporation, their directors, ears, employees and agents (collectively, "Habitat").
"Act	Volunteer and Guardian desire that the Volunteer work as a volunteer for Habitat and engage in the activities related to being a volunteer (the ivities"). The Volunteer and the Guardian understand that the Activities may include constructing and rehabilitating residential buildings, working in Habitat offices, and living in housing provided by volunteers of Habitat.
The	Volunteer and Guardian do hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress execute the Release under the following terms:
1.	<b>Release and Waiver</b> . Volunteer and Guardian do hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless Habitat and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's Activities with Habitat.
Hab whe Hab	inteer and Guardian understand that this Release discharges Habitat from any liability or claim that the Volunteer or Guardian may have against itat with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from Volunteer's Activities with Habitat, other caused by the negligence of Habitat or it's officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. Volunteer and Guardian also understand that itat does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including, but not limited to, medical, lth, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.
pro con	s the policy of Habitat that children under the age of 14 not be allowed on a Habitat worksite while there is construction in gress. It is further the policy of Habitat that, while children between the ages of 16 and 18 may be allowed to participate in struction work, ultra hazardous activity such as using power tools, excavation, demolition or working on rooftops is not permitted anyone under the age of 18.
2.	<b>Medical Treatment</b> . Volunteer and Guardian do hereby release and forever discharge Habitat from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat or with the decision by any representative or ageny of Habitat to exercise the power to consent to medical or dental treatment as such power may be granted and authorized in the Parental Authorization for Treatment of a Minor Child.
3.	Assumption of the Risk. The Volunteer and Guardian understand that the Activities may include work that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from work sites.
	unteer and Guardian hereby expressly and specifically assume the risk of injury or harm in the Activities and release Habitat from all liability for ry, death, or property damage resulting from the Activities.
4.	<b>Insurance</b> . The Volunteer and Guardian understand that, except as otherwise agreed to by Habitat in writing, Habitat does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer.
Eac	h Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his/her own medical/health insurance coverage.
5.	<b>Photographic Release</b> . Volunteer and Guardian do hereby grant and convey unto Habitat all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by Habitat during the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.
6.	<b>Other</b> . Volunteer and Guardian expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Arkansas and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas. Volunteer and Guardian agree that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.
