



GUIDELINES FOR VOLUNTEERS

1. Please be on time for your shift. You to miss the orientation and plan for the day.
2. All volunteers must have a signed waiver. (Waivers stay on file for 1 calendar year.)
3. Volunteers on the work site must be at least 16 years old. Volunteers between 16 and 17 years of age must have a parent or legal guardian sign a waiver.
4. All tools are provided, but you are welcome to bring your own. Please mark them before arrive on the Habitat project site.
5. Appropriate dress:
 - Sturdy, closed toe shoes- for safety reasons sandals are not permitted on site.
 - Construction will take place rain or shine. Dress accordingly. Layers are always a good idea.
 - Don't forget a hat (it keeps both the sun and the rain off!)
 - Work gloves are a good idea.
6. **Water is a must. There will be water available on site, but in an effort to save money and eliminate waste we do not provide individual bottles or cups.**
7. If you need to have a mid-morning or mid-afternoon snack, bring food with you.
8. Please carpool when possible. There is limited parking at the site.
9. Any personal items left at the work site will be removed to our storage facility to a lost and found box. After 30 days items remaining in the lost and found box will be added to our garage sale items. We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.
